## Hispanic Internal Revenue Employees (H.I.R.E.) Los Angeles Chapter

### History

H.I.R.E. was formed in Los Angeles, California, in 1980 after two revenue agents competed unsuccessfully for promotions.

The goals of the organization were to assist the agency in addressing the severe under representation of Hispanics in the IRS workforce, increase the retention of Hispanics and to assist in their career development.

Our organization has grown over the years, and in 1989 the idea of forming a National organization was born. In late 1990 HIRE National was established.



Our organization continues with the commitment to recruit and develop Hispanics.

Our commitment has expanded to incorporate services to the community.

### Benefits our organization offers:

- Networking opportunities for members to feel more “connected” with the organization.
- Developmental workshops to increase knowledge and skills.
- Career counseling and mock interviews to reduce stress and anxiety about interviewing, help boost confidence, and provide with constructive feedback in a low stress environment.
- Provide scholarships to members to continue their education.
